Tera Shield Films may take up to 72 hours to fully cure and bond to the glass. Therefore, we recommend avoiding leaving the vehicle out in extreme weather conditions, driving on rough roads or getting a commercial wash during this period.

Regular Maintenance

- A) Clean your windshield using the below materials at least once per week.
- B) Please make sure you rinse the film well after cleaning.



Cleaning Materials

- A) Use a clean microfiber cloth, sponge, clay bar, or soft brush to prevent scratching



Microfiber Cloth or Sponge



Ammonia-Free Glass Cleaner



Mild Soap & Water



When to Clean Film Surface Immediately

- A) Substances such as tree sap, bird droppings, salt spray, insects, tar, oils etc. should be cleaned off immediately.



Salt Spray



Sap, Bird Droppings



Insects, Tars & Oils



Please Avoid the following;

- A) Using sharp objects or hard bristle brushes on your film
- B) Direct high pressure water spray, stay at least 3 feet away when pressure spraying
- C) Harsh Cleaning Chemicals

Best Practise for Wiper Operation;

- A) Always use washer fluid when operating wipers
- B) Clean underside of the wiper blades regularly
- C) Use Silicone wiper blades and replace blades every 3-6 months
- D) Avoid; Auto-mode, Streaking, Chattering, Smearing, Squeaking during operation
